 - b. COMS 130, 150 or 230 3
 - c. PSYC 104 General Psychology (SOC 104 Sociology can be substituted for admissions purposes) 3
 - d. BIOL 100 and 102 Principles of Biology with Lab 5
 - e. MATH 101 College Algebra 3
 - f. TWO core Soc Science/Arts/Humanities listed below 3
 - g. HSES 250, 260, and 269 10
- No grades lower than "C" will be accepted for HSES, ENGL, MATH, and COMS courses
- Minimum cumulative and core GPAs of 2.75 (including all transfer hours) and a minimum of 31-33 hours required for admission to School of Education. Admission to Community Health program is selective; minimum cumulative and core GPAs do not guarantee admission.
