A bachelor's degree in Sport Science prepares students for careers in sport and fitness related settings outside the public schools. It does NOT prepare students to qualify for teacher certification.

1. An applicant must have completed at least 35-36 specified hours by the time of application and must complete at least 50 hours by the time of admission to the school. The cumulative GPA must be at least 2.75.
2. The following courses (35-36) hours, or the KU equivalents for transfer students, must be completed prior to applying into the Education program:
 - a. ENGL 101 Composition and ENGL 102 Composition and Literature 6
 - b. COMS 130 Speaker-Audience Communication or COMS 150 Personal Communication
or COMS 230 Fundamentals of Debate 3
 - c. BIOL 100 and 102 Principles of Biology with Lab 5
 - d. BIOL 240 Human Anatomy and BIOL 246 Principal of Human Physiology 6
 - e. MATH 101 Algebra or higher (But not MATH 103, 109, and 110) or MATH 104 (**Exercise Science**) 3
 - f. PSYC 104 General Psychology 3
 - g. SOC 104 Elements of Sociology (**Exercise Science**) 3
 - h. ECON 142 or 144 or 140 Economics (**Sports Management**) 3
 - i. **Exercise Science:** HSES 244 Hist & Found PE and HSES 269 Into Exercise Science
 - j. **Sports Management:** HSES 244 History & Foundations of Physical Education, HSES 260 Personal and Community Health, and HSES 289 Intro Sports Management, ACCT 205, DSCI 305, FIN 305, IST 205, MGMT 305 and MKTG 305.
3. Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 in the courses listed under number 2 in order to qualify for admission into the program. No grade lower than a "C" in English, Communication Studies, or Mathematics is acceptable. Having the minimum cumulative and core CPAs does not guarantee admission into the Education program.
