

The Coca-Cola Scholarship For Children of KU Faculty and Staff

Application Process:

- If you indicated on your “Undergraduate Application for Admission and Scholarships” that you are a dependent of a KU employee, that indication is sufficient for you to be considered for the scholarship. **You need not submit this application form to be considered.**
- If you **did not** indicate on your “Undergraduate Application for Admission and Scholarships” that you are a dependent of a KU employee, you **must** submit this application form to be considered for the Coca-Cola Scholarship.

Scholarship Guidelines:

- The scholarship is only available to eligible students pursuing their first undergraduate degree. Graduate, non-degree, and special students are not eligible.
- The awards are guaranteed to students who meet the eligibility requirements below and who apply by the priority deadline, April 1, 2007. Awards cannot be guaranteed after the priority deadline. However every effort will be made to award late applicants based on available funding.

Freshman Scholarship Eligibility:

A one-time \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to first-time, incoming freshmen who:

- Are the children (or step-children claimed as dependents) of benefits eligible KU faculty or staff members (KU affiliates included);
- Are first time, entering freshmen who have not attended another college or university after graduating from high school; and
- Enroll as degree-seeking, full-time students (12 or more credit hours) per semester.

AND

- Have satisfied the criteria for receiving a merit scholarship:
 - High School graduates with an ACT composite score of at least 24, or an SAT combined math and critical reading score of 1090, and a cumulative 2.5 GPA
 - OR**
 - High School graduates with an ACT composite score of at least 21, or an SAT combined math and critical reading score of 980, and a cumulative 3.0 GPA

Scholarship Renewal:

- Students may be eligible for another Coca-Cola Scholarship for each subsequent year of the undergraduate program as long as the student still meets the terms of the scholarship guidelines and eligibility.
- Current recipients of a Coca-Cola Scholarship will be considered for automatic renewal of the scholarship as soon as grades are available for the Spring semester 2007.
- Subsequent awards will be awarded competitively based on the applicant’s KU cumulative grade point average and upon the availability of funds. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 is required to be considered.

Priority scholarship deadline: April 1, 2007

You need to submit this application form **only if you did not mark** the application for admission that you are a dependent of a KU employee.

An official high school transcript must be on file in the Office of Admissions and Scholarships.

Applications received after the priority deadline (April 1, 2007) will be reviewed based on available funding.

Note: Applications must be complete in order to be reviewed.
