

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

This application is to be used by students who have never attended KU and who wish to pursue a college degree. You may print out the PDF application and mail it in OR apply online at www.admissions.ku.edu/apply. Please do not do both.

If you have attended KU in the past, please fill out a readmit application.

If you wish to take courses at KU but not pursue a college degree, please fill out a non-degree seeking application.

Once your application is completed, sign and mail it along with your credit card information or a \$30 check or money order to

APPLICATIONS CANNOT BE FAXED

College transcripts may be faxed directly from the school for an admission decision and/or scholarship consideration. We must receive an official mailed transcript from the school to post transfer credits to your record.

High school transcripts in progress may be faxed directly from the school for an admission decision and/or scholarship consideration. We must receive an official final mailed transcript from the school with graduation date as soon as graduation is posted to your transcript. Final high school transcripts with graduation date cannot be faxed.

In addition to your application, we will also need the following information before your application will be considered complete.

If you are applying as a freshman:

- An official high school transcript sent to KU by your school
- ACT and/or SAT test scores if they are not on your transcript

If you are applying as a transfer student with fewer than 24 graded credit hours at the time of your application:

- An official final high school transcript mailed to KU by your school
- ACT and/or SAT test scores if they are not on your transcript (waived if you are over 21 years old)
- Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended

If you are applying as a transfer student with more than 24 graded credit hours:

- Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended

Note: International documents must have English translations.

For scholarship consideration you will need the following additional information:

- Co-curricular summary – A list of your activities during high school: clubs, sports, church and community organizations, etc.
- Scholarship essay – A 500-word essay on one of three essay questions.

I. Applicant Information

Legal Name

Please enter your legal first and last names and your middle name on these lines. The names you list here must match exactly the name on your drivers license, passport, military or state ID card. You must have this document with you to verify your name when you receive your KU ID card.

Other Last Names

If you have ever used another last name, list it here.

Preferred First Name

This is the space to enter any nickname or shortened version of your first name that you go by.

First Generation College Student

If your parents or grandparents did not attend college, you are a first generation college student.

Social Security Number

Enter your social security number here. You are not required to provide this information but if you don't, you will not be able to check your application status online, have your ACT/SAT test scores matched to your application or have your application reviewed for financial aid.

Gender

Please check the appropriate box.

Birth Date

Enter the month, day and year that you were born.

Mailing Address

Be sure to include your full mailing address with house or apartment number, city, state and ZIP code.

If you are a Kansas resident, please enter the county you live in.

Permanent Home

Please enter the city, state, ZIP code and county that you consider your permanent home.

Phone/E-mail Address

Please provide the area code and phone number where we can reach you and leave a voice message. We also need a current e-mail address.

Citizenship

Check the "yes" box if you are a U.S. citizen. If you check "yes," skip the other questions in this section and proceed to the "Race and Ethnic Background" section.

If you check the "no" box because you are not a U.S. citizen, please answer the following questions in this section.

If you are a permanent resident, please enter your alien registration number in the space provided and make a copy of

Race and Ethnic Background

Although ethnic background information does not affect your admission, it helps KU comply with federal and state reporting laws. Please check all boxes that apply.

Also check the appropriate box if English is or is not your first language.

2. Parent or Guardian Information

Enter the name of your parent(s) or guardian, along with his or her phone number and home address, city, state and ZIP code. Provide an e-mail address if this is a good way to contact him/her.

If you have parents who maintain separate residences, please provide this information for the second parent on a separate sheet of paper.

If any of your parents, siblings or grandparents graduated from or are currently attending KU, please list their names in the space provided.

3. Kansas Residency Information

Check “yes” if you are currently living in Kansas. Provide dates for any period you have lived in Kansas, along with the most recent Kansas address.

Let us know if you are a dependent of a KU employee and answer the military questions.

4. Enrollment Status

Check the box for the term you plan to enter KU and check the box to indicate if you will be a freshman or transfer student.

If you have ever applied to KU, indicate the semester and year you applied.

5. Area of Academic Interest

Refer to the list of academic interests provided.

Once you have selected an interest, enter it on the line provided.

If you want to double major, please e-mail your request to us at processing@ku.edu.

6. Educational Information

Enter the name of your high school and the city and state it is located in.

If you are home schooled, please enter “home school.” If you took the GED, enter “GED” and request that your test scores be sent to KU.

If you have taken or will be taking the ACT/SAT, please check the appropriate boxes and list the month/year of the testing.

Courses in Progress

Freshmen should list all courses for both fall and spring semesters of their senior year in high school plus any college courses.

Transfer students should list the courses currently being taken and plan to take before entering KU.

Colleges, Universities, Vocational or Technical Institutions Attended

Give the name of the school, location and dates attended of ALL schools attended. Use a second sheet of paper if necessary.

Estimated College Credits

Check the box which indicates the number of college credit hours you will have completed at the time of your application to KU – do not count courses you are currently taking.

7. Work Experience

List the company name, city and state, and dates of employment for each job you’ve held for the past year.

If you did not work, please list what you were doing — volunteering, traveling, stay-at-home parent, etc.

Use a second sheet of paper if necessary.
