RESIDENCE HALLS A traditional-style show room in Hashinger and McCollum residence halls are available for tours on Mondays, Wednesdays & Fridays when classes are in session for the Summer (June 4th – July 25th).

Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays: Meet in the KU Visitor Center lobby at 11:30 or 1:00 and a tour guide will walk you over to the residence halls. You may also stop by any of the above residence halls on your own between 11:00 – 1:00 p.m. for a tour.

LUNCH If you are interested in eating lunch at Mrs. E's, Oliver, or GSP/Corbin Cafeterias, you can ask for a voucher at the front desk of the KU Visitor Center. The voucher allows for you to buy one meal and get one at half price.
